



## **Advisory – Change in Protocols for Movement of Essential Goods across Containment and Non-containment Zones in Viti-Levu**

As at 24 May 2021, the Ministry of Health and Medical Services (MHMS) in consultation with the Ministry of Commerce, Trade, Tourism and Transport (MCTTT) has amended conditions in relation to the movement of essential goods across containment and non-containment zones in Viti-Levu.

The amended conditions on the aforementioned have been highlighted as follows:

1. All delivery vehicles must change drivers at the border of the containment and non-containment zones. For example, a vehicle travelling from Suva can travel as far as the Wainadoi border and the change of drivers will occur at the Wainadoi border for the vehicle to be taken at the premises in Sigatoka. If the delivery needs to go to Lautoka, then there must be a driver change at the Momi border.
2. Garbage collection trucks and other vehicles specifically approved by the MHMS are exempted from the requirement to change drivers at containment borders.
3. Direct movement of essential goods are only permissible across containment zones. For example, movement of essential goods from Lautoka to Nadi only and from Nausori to Wainadoi only.
4. Exchange of drivers must take place at the borders of containment and non-containment zones including Wainadoi, Logani, Matawalu and Momi.
5. If you have an existing movement of essential goods pass, you can continue exchanging essential goods until 31 May 2021.
